General Information: The TAG Annual is a juried exhibition for regional artists. All work must be original, current *(completed within the last three years).*

Eligibility: Open to regional artists *living within a 100-mile radius of Trumbull County*. Work in any medium will be considered. Up to three artworks may be entered.

Hanging 2-D artwork: 2 -D art must be ready to hang by wire or a sawtooth hanger mounted at the top center of the piece. **Displaying 3-D artwork:** 3-D works must be ready to display on the floor, pedestal, or shelf. Work cannot be hung from the ceiling. Work can be hung off the wall by a rod or bracket as long as they are provided.

Size restrictions: 2-D artwork must not exceed 60 inches in length or width. 3-D artwork must not exceed 72 inches in height, length, or width.

To Enter:

1) Fill out and sign entry form and labels. Attach label(s) to back upper-left corner of artworks (or underside, if 3-D).

2)Hand deliver entries to the Trumbull Art Gallery, 158-162 N. Park Ave., Warren, Ohio, during the drop-off date: Saturday, June 24th from 11a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
