Exhibition Overview:

The Trumbull Art Gallery (TAG) is honoring sculptor Tony Armeni for his decades of dedication as an artist, art educator & musician in the Mahoning Valley. As part of this tribute, TAG is curating an exhibition that will feature sculptures from Tony Armeni and works by artists who have studied with him, his peers and the arts community.

We are inviting **visual artists** to submit works that explore the intersection of **sound and visual art**. We encourage artists to experiment with sound in innovative ways—whether through sound-producing elements within the artwork itself, the inclusion of sound as a component of the installation, or by visually representing sound in a way that evokes an auditory experience. Sound is not a requirement to enter the exhibition for Visual Artists.

The Role of Sound in the Exhibition

Sound will play a transformative role in this exhibition. It will not only showcase the artists' work but will also evoke a deeper, more visceral response from those experiencing it. Enhancing the connection between the sculptures, artwork, space and the people interacting with them.

4. **Connection to Tony Armeni** – Briefly describe your relationship to Tony Armeni (e.g., former student, peer, collaborator, etc.).
